Sixth Form Choices at The Coleshill School – OPTION GUIDE

We offer a wide range of Advanced (level 3) courses. The majority are traditional A levels but the BTEC Diploma (worth three A levels) and the Cambridge Technical in ICT are increasingly popular. The most important thing is to match your choices to your University and Career plans and think carefully about which subjects you are most likely to succeed in. Take advice from teachers, tutors and parents in the first instance but each student will be given an interview with a senior member of staff. Mr Owen is always available to give advice about appropriate choices.

Entry requirements: The general entry requirement is at least 5 A*- C grades at GCSE (The new English and Maths require a grade 5 as the C equivalent) Certain subjects have specific entry requirements which can be checked on the subject descriptions on the website. Those students who do not gain the minimum government requirement for English/Maths will be required to resit.

For level 2 courses we require at least 4 A* - D grades and will offer the opportunity to Resit English and/or Maths as above.
