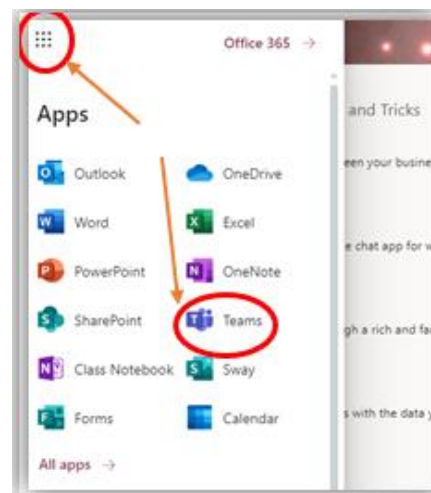

>Click “sign in”

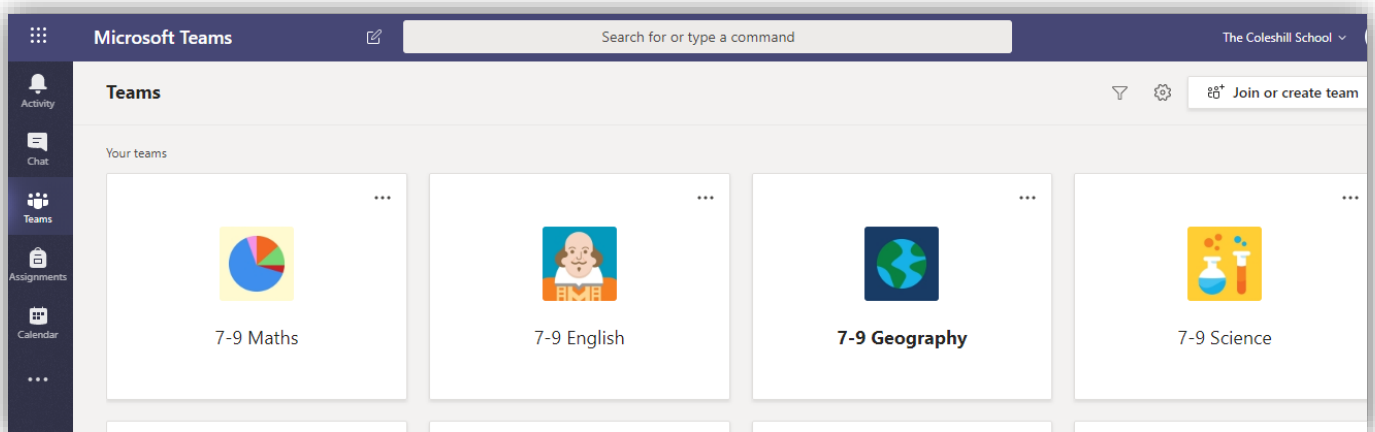
> Enter your school email address and password and sign in.

You will then be able to see all the subject teams you are included in

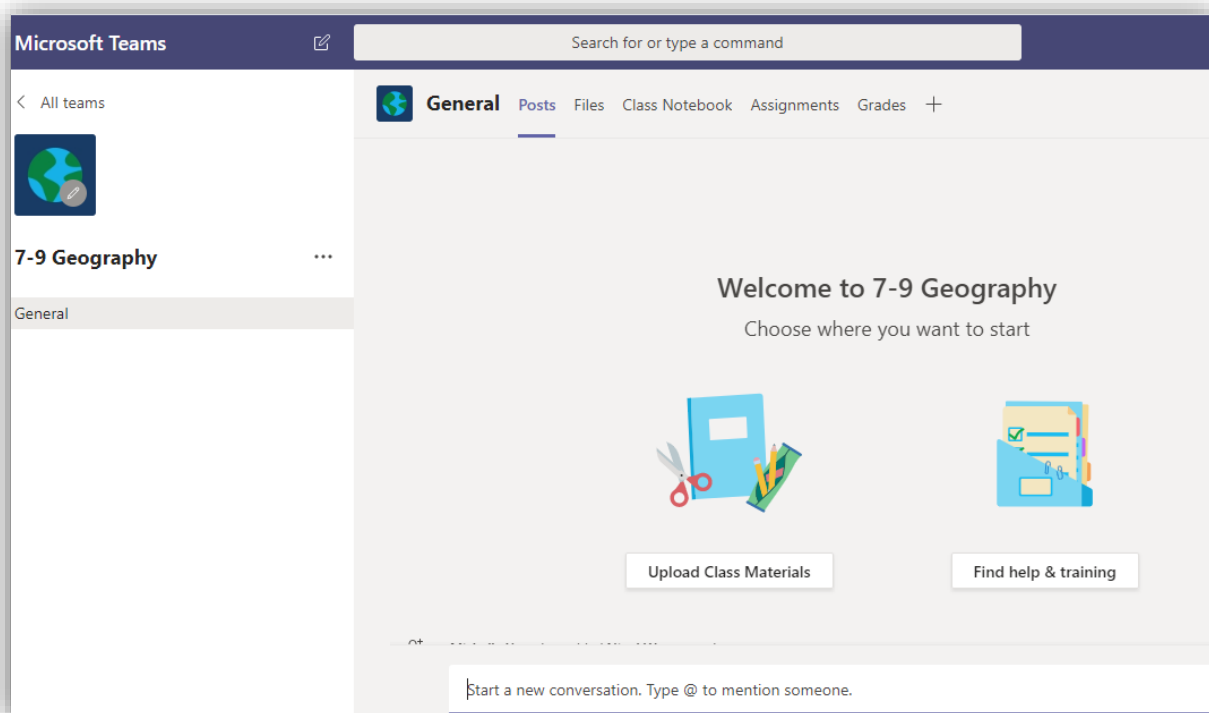


If you do not know the password to your Office 365 account (email account) then please email passwords@thecoleshillschool.org and we will get this reset for you as soon as possible.
