Sixth Form Choices at The Coleshill School – OPTION GUIDE

We offer a wide range of Advanced (level 3) courses. The majority are traditional A levels but we also offer a number of BTEC options including the BTEC Diploma (worth three A levels). The most important thing is to match your choices to your University and Career plans and think carefully about which subjects you are most likely to succeed in. Take advice from teachers, tutors and parents in the first instance but each student will be given an interview with a senior member of staff. Mr Owen is always available to give advice about appropriate choices.

Entry requirements: Students are required to achieve a minimum of 5 passes at grade 4 and above including maths and English , but must achieve at least a 5 (or higher if stipulated by the entry requirements for individual subjects) for the subjects they wish to study. Where the A level subject has not been studied at GCSE level a grade5 in a related/equivalent subject is required. Those who do not achieve a level 4 in English or maths will be required to resit in year12.
